PROMOTION**

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Information on how to enter and the prize(s) form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Entry is only open to Australian residents aged 18 years or over.
3. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, participating retailers and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1<sup>st</sup> cousin.

5. A “**Participating Retailer**” is any of the following off-premise retailers:
  - Nationwide: Bottlemart, Bottlemart Express, Sip n Save or Harry Browns; or
  - WA only: Thirsty Camel.For the avoidance of doubt, online purchases from these retailers are also eligible for this promotion.
6. To be eligible to enter, individuals must spend \$20 or more in a single transaction on any Matso’s product/s from a Participating Retailer during the Promotional Period.
7. To enter, individuals must then visit <https://matsos.gooddrinkshub.com.au/matsos-sunshine-coast-giveaway/>, follow the prompts to the promotion entry page, input the requested details, upload a copy of their purchase receipt and submit the fully completed entry form during the Promotional Period.
